We accept cash or credit card only. NO checks are accepted. Payment is due in full BEFORE surgery is performed.

EXTRA INFORMATION

Before the Surgery: It is highly recommended that you take your pet to your regular veterinarian for a wellness exam before scheduling your pet's surgery. This will confirm your pet is healthy enough for spay/neuter. If your pet is found unfit for surgery the day of the clinic, you will be rescheduled or a refund will be submitted to the treasurer. Payments cannot be refunded the same day.

- You will need to pull the food from your pet the **night before** surgery, confirming your pet will be fasted by midnight the night before, do **NOT** feed them in the morning. They can still have access to water up until drop off.
- You will make sure your pet is kept inside overnight before surgery and after surgery up to 24 hours for recovery if needed.
- You will need to bring a paper copy of your pet's current rabies vaccine, so please have this printed before entry of the clinic. If you do **not** have proof, your pet will receive the vaccine for an additional fee.

Day of Surgery: You and your fasted pet will need to arrive between **8am - 8:30am** the day of surgery. No early or late entry will be accepted. **When you arrive, please park in the rear of the building and stay in your car. A staff member will come to the car with necessary paperwork to go over and sign.** Payment will be due at the time of drop off.

- Your cat must be dropped off in a cat carrier and your dog must be secured with a leash. **NOTE: ONLY one (1) animal per carrier, EACH animal MUST have it's own carrier.**
- You will leave a contact number that you can be reached at throughout the day. In case of an emergency, we will need to be able to get a hold of you. In the chance you do not pick up the phone, emergency decisions will have to be made by the clinic staff. It is important that you plan ahead for this.
- Your pet will receive an exam before surgery is performed. If your pet is deemed unfit for surgery, you will be called to come and pick up your pet.
- You will be given a scheduled pick-up time the day of surgery (ranging between 2pm-4pm). You will need to pick up your pet at the scheduled time, no exceptions. If you do not pick up your pet by the scheduled time, you **WILL** be charged a late fee (\$25/day). **During pickups, we will have you again stay in your car and we will bring your animal out to you.**

After the Surgery: You will be responsible for following the discharge instructions given to you carefully. If you have any medical issues after surgery, you will need to bring your pet to your **regular** veterinarian. The SPCA does **not** provide any additional medical treatment after discharge of your pet.

- The clinic staff recommend your pet wear an e-collar to prevent licking at the incision. These can be bought at your local pet store or online before the day of surgery and the SPCA also sells e-collars at our clinic.

I have read all of the information above and filled out the previous page to the best of my knowledge.
